State: Ohio

Assessment:

Ohio State Tests, OELPA, OELPS, OGT

Applied for waiver: no

Opt out process for parents:

Not supported, due to consequences. But parents have opted out.

Federal restrictions to opt out: none

Consequences of opt out: n/a

Students may not get promoted to grade 4, due to reading. Students will be unable to exit ELL. Students will be removed from school after 2 years of opt out. If the district does not get 95% participation, they may face funding restrictions. Teacher Evaluations may be effected. Students who opt out will not help or hinder the index score.

Changes in testing requirements:

Testing must still occur in person. It may only not happen if the environment is deemed unsafe. Districts can choose to wait till spring of 2021.
